CYCLONE GAJA ACTIVITIES

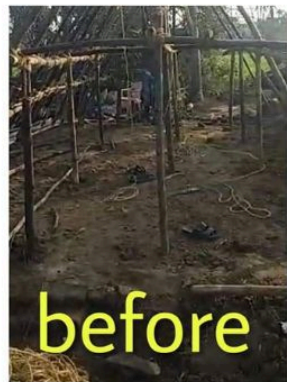
